Pursuant to Section 18004(e) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relieve and Economic Security Act (CARES ACT), Dragon Rises College of Oriental Medicine ("the College" or DRCOM) acknowledges the college has signed and returned the agreement and acceptance of funds distributed from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). DRCOM received grand funds in the amount of \$18,040.00 and distributed \$9020.16 as Emergency Financial Aid Grants for students, meeting the requirement to use no less than 50 percent of funds received. Below is the Breakdown of funds, per reporting requirements.

The total number of students eligible for receipt of Emergency Financial Aid Grants under the CARES Act is 26. The college sent out forms to each individual student for them to choose if they wanted to receive the grant. All forms were returned, and two students declined the funds. Twenty-four students received the Emergency Financial Aid Grant money, with each student receiving \$375.84.


