Good Afternoon Students,

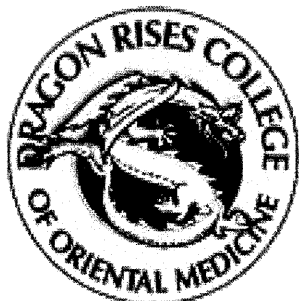
The CARES Act Grant money is in and your **check is ready now**. I was able to award everyone \$1,018.50.
